PETITION IN RELATION TO WHITE SET PLASTER

To the President and Members of the Legislative Council of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned residents of Western Australia note that in May 2014 the Building Commission publicly recognised consumer concerns that defective plaster work was leading to peeling paint on their walls. In response to these concerns the White Set Plaster Working Group was established. Subsequent to comprehensive testing a report was given to the Group which included the Department of Commerce Building Commission representatives.

Your petitioners therefore respectfully request that the Legislative Council investigate the impact on consumers given concerns with the quality of the white set plaster and paint adherence to walls. Further, we request the Legislative Council investigate the Building Commission's delay in making the Government aware of the true nature and extent of the issue and the urgency required to ensure current and future home owners are not disadvantaged by substandard white set plaster.
