DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING — VACANT LOT — MIRRABOOKA

4694. Ms J.M. Freeman to the Minister representing the Minister for Housing:

With respect to the Department of Housing vacant lot on the corner Farrier Road and Saddlier Circle Mirrabooka:

- (a) how long has the DOH owned the lot;
- (b) what does the DOH plan for the lot;
- (c) will the DOH develop the lot;
- (d) when will the DOH develop the lot;
- (e) will the DOH sell the lot; and
- (f) when will the DOH sell the lot?

Mr D.T. Redman replied:

The Housing Authority advises:

- (a) 10 years.
- (b)–(c) The site has been identified as a secondary activity centre in Directions 2031 and as such the Housing Authority will work with the City of Stirling and other potential partners to develop options for the site.
- (d) When a suitable option that meets Housing's development outcomes is determined.
- (e)–(f) At this stage Housing does not intend to sell this site.

MINISTERIAL OFFICES — MEETINGS — ALSTOM LTD

4703. Mr W.J. Johnston to the Minister for State Development:
