

TRANSPORT (ROAD PASSENGER SERVICES) AMENDMENT BILL 2018

Introduction and First Reading

Bill introduced, on motion by **Ms R. Saffioti (Minister for Transport)**, and read a first time.

Explanatory memorandum presented by the minister.

Second Reading

MS R. SAFFIOTI (West Swan — Minister for Transport) [12.59 pm]: I move —

That the bill be now read a second time.

This bill is to be considered in conjunction with division 2 of part 9 of the Transport (Road Passenger Services) Bill 2018, which I have already introduced. This amendment bill will introduce a levy on bookings for certain on-demand passenger transport services in connection with the proposed buyback of owned taxi plates issued under the Taxi Act 1994. Section 46(7) of the Constitution Acts Amendment Act 1899 requires a separate bill to impose the levy, and that is this bill.

I commend the bill to the house.
