1 By Letters Patent issued on 20 July 1868 Sir Benjamin Chilley Campbell *Pine* was appointed Governor but he did not take up the appointment and on 14 April 1869 Frederick Aloysius *Weld* was appointed "in the room of Sir Benjamin *Pine*".
