# Gender composition of Australian parliaments by party: a quick guide

This Quick Guide provides an update to tables showing the composition of Australian parliaments by party and gender (see Tables 1 and 2 below) since the last version was published on 23 January 2023.

#### Commonwealth

#### Senate

Senator <u>Jim Molan</u> (LIB, NSW) died in office on 16 January 2023. The casual vacancy has not yet been filled.

Senator <u>Lidia Thorpe</u> (Vic.) <u>announced</u> on 6 February 2023 that she was leaving the Australian Greens to sit as an independent.

### House of Representatives

A <u>by-election</u> in the electorate of Aston (Vic.) resulting from the resignation of <u>Alan Tudge</u> (LIB) was held on Saturday 1 April 2023, and was won by <u>Mary Doyle</u> (ALP).

#### **New South Wales**

Following the general election held on 25 March 2023, women now comprise:

40.9% of the Legislative Assembly

45.2% of the Legislative Council

42.5% of the NSW parliament as a whole

For the first time in NSW the Ministry has gender parity with 11 of 22 positions filled by women.

#### **Victoria**

## **Legislative Council**

On 27 March 2023 <u>Moira Deeming</u> (Western Metropolitan) was <u>suspended from the Liberal party</u> <u>room</u> for nine months and now sits as an <u>Independent Liberal</u>.

## **Legislative Assembly**

A <u>supplementary election</u> in the Narracan District following the death of a candidate during the election campaign period was held on 28 January 2023, which was won by <u>Wayne Farnham</u> (LIB).

#### **Western Australia**

## **Legislative Council**

<u>Alannah MacTiernan</u> (ALP, South West Region) resigned from parliament on 10 February 2023. She was replaced by <u>Ben Dawkins</u> on 20 March 2023, who now sits as an independent after being expelled by the ALP.

#### **South Australia**

#### **Legislative Council**

<u>Stephen Wade</u> (LIB) resigned from parliament on 27 January 2023 and <u>was replaced</u> by <u>Ben Hood</u> (LIB).

## **Northern Territory**

A <u>by-election</u> for the seat of Arafura on 18 March 2023 following the death of <u>Lawrence Costa</u> (ALP) was won by <u>Manuel Brown</u> (ALP).
