## INTRODUCTION

This paper contains a summary of the 2001 Western Australian election. It contains details of voting for all Legislative Assembly districts, initial analysis of Assembly preference flows, as well as summaries of voting for the Legislative Council.

For each Legislative Assembly electorate, details of the total primary and two-candidate preferred vote are provided. Where appropriate, a two-party preferred count is also included. The format for the results is as follows:

First Count: For each candidate, the total primary vote received is shown. Percentage votes are calculated as a percentage of the formal vote for each electorate. Swing is calculated by subtracting the percentage vote received by a party at the 1996 election from the percentage received at the 2001 election. Where the parties contesting the district differ from the 1996 election, 'ghost' candidates (indicated by "...") have been included representing candidates not contesting the current election. As a result, all primary swings add to zero, subject to rounding errors.

Final Count: Represents the two-candidate preferred count after the final distribution of preferences in an electorate. All formal votes that did not indicate a preference for the final two candidates are included in the total listed as exhausted. Two-candidate preferred percentages are calculated by dividing the two-candidate preferred vote for a candidate by the total votes remaining in the count, that is the formal votes minus the total of exhausted votes. Two-candidate preferred swings are shown compared to the results of the 1996 election. Where the party composition of the final two candidates differs from the 1996 election (eg Alfred Cove), a ghost candidate appears, and three swing figures are shown. Separate two-party preferred counts are also included in several electorates.

### Exhausted Votes

Under the WA Electoral Act, ballot papers with a valid first preference vote, but with duplicate numbering in subsequent preferences, remain in the count as formal votes. This type of vote is often termed a 'Langer' vote, after the political activist who advocated voting in this manner when the same formality rules applied for Commonwealth elections.

During the distribution of preferences, it will not always be possible to determine the next available preference for ballot papers with duplicate preference numbering. As a result, these votes are set aside as 'exhausted' preferences at the point in the count where the next available preference cannot be determined. They are not counted towards the final two-candidate preferred count for an electorate. After the distribution of preferences, a candidate is declared elected if he or she receives 50% of the votes remaining in the count, that is the formal vote less the total number of exhausted preferences. Note that where both two-candidate and two-party preferred counts are provided for an electorate, the total number of exhausted votes may be different for the two counts.

In the result tables, two-candidate and two-party preferred percentages are calculated as a percentage of votes remaining in the count. An exhausted vote total is also shown, along with a percentage exhausted vote, calculated by dividing the total exhausted vote by the formal vote.

### Two-Candidate Preferred versus Two-Party Preferred Results

The two-candidate preferred count for an electorate is defined as the final tally after the exclusion and distribution as preferences of votes from all other candidates. At each stage of the count, the candidate with the least votes is excluded, and his or her votes are distributed to candidates remaining in the count based on the voter's preferences as filled in on the ballot paper. To achieve victory, a candidate must receive more than 50% of the vote remaining in the count, though in electorates where a candidate achieves victory either on the primary vote or before the final distribution of preferences, a two-candidate preferred count is carried out in full for information purposes.

The two-party preferred count represents a distribution of preferences between candidates representing the Labor Party and the Liberal-National Party Coalition. Candidates are again excluded

based on lowest progressive vote, though at some points the second lowest candidate is excluded to retain candidates representing Labor and the Coalition. In most cases, the two-party preferred count will be the same as the two-candidate preferred count. However, at the 2001 election, the final distribution of preferences in 11 electorates did not represent a two-party preferred contest, and in most of these electorates, the West Australian Electoral Commission carried out additional two-party preferred counts for information purposes.

Two-party preferred votes and percentages are familiar in Australian election analysis from their use in electoral pendulums to show the relative safety of seats, and also to illustrate the notional swing required in marginal seats for a change of government. A statewide two-party preferred count, calculated by summing the two-party preferred counts in individual electorates, has often been used to measure any discrepancy between seats won and votes received by governments and oppositions. However, it must be stressed that the two-candidate preferred count is the real result in each electorate. Given that 11 electorates did not finish as a two-party contest, analysis of the statewide two-party preferred totals is a theoretical exercise not connected with the actual decisions made by voters in electorates. A table of statewide two-party preferred results is provided on pages 22-23, and for comparison purposes, a statewide two-candidate preferred count has also been calculated.

In the following electorates, the assumptions made to create a two-party preferred vote need some explanation.

Alfred Cove: The Labor Party did not nominate a candidate for the 2001 election, and the two-candidate preferred contest took place between Liberal Party candidate Doug Shave and Liberals for Forests candidate Janet Woollard. The Western Australian Electoral Commission (WAEC) also conducted a distribution of preferences between Shave and Independent Denise Brailey, and this count has been adopted as the notional two-party preferred count in the relevant tables. As an independent also finished second at the 1996 election, the WAEC's 1996 two-party preferred count is used where appropriate.

Armadale: The Liberal Party did not nominate a candidate for the 2001 election. The two-candidate preferred vote for Independent Roger Stubbs has been used as the notional non-Labor two-party preferred count.

Churchlands: In 1996, the Liberal Party did not nominate a candidate and the final distribution of preferences took place between the Labor candidate and Independent Liz Constable, with this count also used as the notional two-party preferred count. In 2001, the Liberal Party nominated a candidate, and the two-candidate preferred count finished as a contest between Constable and the Liberal party. The WAEC conducted two other preference counts, one between Labor and Liberal candidates, and the second between Labor and Constable. In this publication, the Labor/Liberal count has been used as the two-party preferred result, which inflates the swing to Labor at the 2001 election. The following table shows the difference in swing that would be produced if the Labor/Constable count were used as the two-party preferred vote.

Greenough: The two-candidate preferred count finished as a contest between the Liberal and One Nation candidates. A separate two-party preferred count was conducted between Liberal and Labor candidates.

Kimberley: No Labor Party candidate nominated for the 1996 election, and the electorate was won by ex-Labor MP Ernie Bridge as an Independent. His vote has been used as the Labor two-party preferred vote for 1996.

Merredin: The two-candidate preferred count finished as a contest between National and One Nation candidates. A separate two-party preferred count was conducted between National and Labor candidates.

Moore: The two-candidate preferred count finished as a contest between Liberal and One Nation candidates. A separate two-party preferred count was conducted between Labor and Liberal candidates.

Nedlands: This electorate finished as a contest between candidates representing the Liberal Party and Liberals for Forests. A second two-party preferred count was conducted between Liberal and Labor candidates.

Peel: In 1996 the Liberal Party dis-endorsed its candidate after ballot papers had been printed. The final two-candidate preferred count between Labor and an Independent has been taken as the two-party preferred vote.

Pilbara: In 2001, this electorate finished as a contest between the Labor candidate and Independent and former Labor MP Larry Graham. Two additional two-party preferred counts were conducted, one between Labor and Liberal candidates, and a second between Graham and the Liberal candidate. In this publication, the Liberal/Labor count has been used as the two-party preferred vote. The following table shows the differences in swing that would be produced if the Graham/Liberal count were used as the two-party preferred vote.

Roe: Finished as a National/Independent contest in 1996, and a National/One Nation contest in 2001. Separate two-party preferred counts were conducted by the WAEC at both elections.

South Perth: In both 1996 and 2001, the contest was between Independent Philip Pandal and the Liberal Party. Two-party preferred analysis is based upon two-party counts provided for both election by the WAEC.

Wagin: In 2001, the two-candidate preferred count finished as a contest between candidates representing the Liberal and National Parties. A second two-party preferred count between Labor and National candidates has been used where appropriate.

### **Non-registered Political Parties**

Candidates representing seven registered political parties contested the 2001 election, and the party affiliation of these candidates appeared on all ballot papers. All other candidates appeared on ballot papers either as Independents, or with no party affiliation.

However, some of these candidates were members of unregistered political parties. This publication has recognised three of these unregistered parties, Liberals for Forests, the Seniors Party and the Curtin Labor Alliance. Candidates nominating for these parties have been identified in all electorate results, and Liberals for Forests have also been included in the regional summary tables. However, as unregistered parties, the names of these three parties did not appear on the ballot paper, nor will they be identified in the statistical returns published by the WAEC.

Another registered party, the Christian Democratic Party, changed its name from Call to Australia for the 2001 election. Where the Christian Democratic Party appears in this publication, its vote has been compared to that received by Call to Australia in 1996.

### **Sitting Member Indicators**

An asterisk "\*" is used to indicate any candidate who is currently a sitting member of the chamber they are contesting. This is the case even where the sitting MP is contesting a different electorate or region.

At the 1996 election, the electorate of Pilbara was won by Mr Larry Graham for the Labor Party, but he subsequently resigned from the party to sit as an Independent. While Mr Graham is shown as the sitting Independent MP, in most tables his electorate has been classed as a Labor-held electorate. In the table of seats changing hands at the 2001 election, Pilbara is shown as being gained by Independents.

### **Acknowledgement and Disclaimer**

My thanks to the staff of the Western Australian Electoral Commission for their help in making available two-party preferred counts and primary votes for the Legislative Council ahead of their release in the statistical returns. All other results have been taken from the WAEC's web site (<http://www.waec.wa.gov.au>). While most results are checked and final, there may be some minor adjustments before the Statistical Returns are finalised.

All calculations of percentages and swing are the responsibility of the author.

## DISTRIBUTION OF LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY PREFERENCES BY PARTY

The tables on the following pages provide a summary of the distribution of preferences for One Nation, Greens (WA) and Liberals for Forests candidates. The small number of electorates where Labor preferences were counted is also included.

Each table groups together electorates by the party excluded and by the combination of party candidates remaining in the count. The analysis concentrates on the last distribution of preferences where votes are distributed to the final two candidates remaining in the count. However, several tables for One Nation and the Greens (WA) show the second last distribution of preferences where three candidates remain in the count.

In all tables, electorates are grouped together by the number of contesting candidates. The percentage preference flow to other parties is shown, as well as the percentage primary vote received by the excluded candidate and the total percentage primary vote and party affiliation of previously excluded candidates. The percentage of exhausted preferences is also shown.

In all electorates with more than three candidates, the preference flows of the excluded party will be affected by the distribution of preferences from previously excluded candidates. The preference flows are calculated on all votes held by a candidate at the point when they were excluded, meaning the percentages will be based on both the excluded candidate's primary vote, as well as any votes received as preferences from other candidates. So for instance, the tables of Greens (WA) preferences will also include votes previously transferred from Australian Democrat candidates.

At the 2001 election, there was considerable interest in the tactic adopted by Pauline Hanson's One Nation to direct preferences against sitting MPs. To assess the tactic's impact, the table below shows the flow of preferences from One Nation candidates in electorates held by each of the major parties. (Detailed distributions can be found on the next page.)

Analysis of this table is complicated by several factors. In several Liberal held electorates, preferences were directed to the sitting member. The number of One Nation how-to-vote cards handed out varied from electorate to electorate, and in some electorates, the major parties attempted to influence One Nation voters with their own how-to-vote cards. However in summary it can be concluded that One Nation preferences did flow against sitting members, but the flow of preferences was weak compared to the flows produced by Greens (WA) how-to-vote cards.

Strong flows of Green preferences enabled the Labor Party to win several electorates in which its candidate trailed on the primary count. Compared to this, One Nation preferences were less important in assisting Labor's victory. However, as the change in primary vote suggest One Nation drew most of its support from the Coalition, the relatively even split of One Nation preferences effectively transformed half of the Coalition's loss of primary vote into an after preferences swing to Labor.
