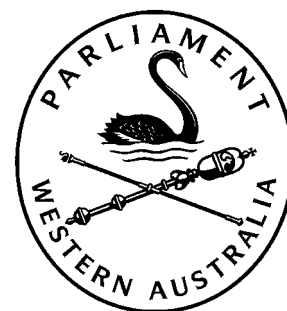

Comments and Feedback

This publication has been prepared with reference to the electoral maps made available by the Electoral Distribution Commission. However, without access to registered voter lists indicating where people cast their vote, and given the scale on some maps, re-allocating booths to new electorates is an imprecise science, especially where booths have to be split. INTRODUCTION

This publication contains estimates of the political impact of the Western Australian state electoral boundaries, released by the Electoral Redistribution Commission on 4 August 2003. The publication has been prepared by re-assigning votes cast at the 2001 state election so as to match the new electoral boundaries. The following notes provide an explanation of how the results have been re-calculated as well as how to read the tables provided.

Changes from Draft Boundaries

The major changes between the draft and final boundaries are as follows –

- As in the draft boundaries, Burrup has been abolished, but the final maps adopt the boundary of Roebourne Shire as the dividing line for the new electorates. Three Mining and Pastoral Region seats adopt new names compared to the draft boundaries, Ningaloo becoming North West Coastal, Eyre now Murchison-Eyre, and Pilbara re-named Central Kimberley-Pilbara. On the final boundaries, the notional Labor majority in North West Coastal has been increased.
- Joondalup has been re-instated as the name for the proposed electorate of Heathridge. Adjustments to the boundaries mean Joondalup is notionally stronger for Labor than the proposed Heathridge, while the new Mindarie has its notional Labor majority weakened slightly.
- Changes to the boundary between Agricultural and South West Regions have seen adjustments to Stirling, Wagin and Warren-Blackwood, while Roe reverts to its previous boundaries.
- The proposed transfer of voters from Riverton to Southern River has been reversed.

This publication also shows slight changes to the estimated new margins in Darling Range, Kenwick and Serpentine-Jarrahdale. These are not as a result of changes in the final boundaries, but from a review of the way the author originally split the booths on the draft boundaries. The placement of booths in the old electorate of Roleystone, along with the adoption of the Tonkin and Brookton Highways as new boundaries, makes exact calculations difficult.

A Caution on Using New Boundary Estimates

As elections are conducted by secret ballot, it is impossible to be certain that in transferring votes to new boundaries the calculations are absolutely correct. On the new electoral pendulum, several electorates are calculated with new majorities of fewer than 120 votes. Such precision is not really possible, and the margins in close seats should be viewed as a guide to marginality rather than a precise statement of which party holds a seat.

Moving votes to new electorates is based on the assumption that votes were cast for parties rather than candidates. This is a reasonable assumption as long as it does not forget that a high profile candidate in a particular electorate can increase the vote for a party. There are also special difficulties with Independent candidates, where it is almost impossible to calculate their level of support in areas added to an electorate. While I have made some attempt to do this with the tables beginning on page 40, these calculations are highly speculative.

Re-allocating votes to new boundaries also overlooks the varying level of intensity in party campaigning from electorate to electorate. For instance, in the new electorate of Geraldton, the Labor Party vote is likely to be higher in booths from the old Geraldton, where the Labor Party ran an active campaign, than in the booths transferred from the safe Liberal seat of Greenough, where the Labor Party's campaign was more subdued.

Above all, the re-calculated figures should not be viewed as predictions of future results, or even past outcomes. On the calculations in this paper, it appears the number of seats held by

all parties remains unchanged on the new boundaries compared to the 2001 election result. This is a reasonable observation, but cannot be asserted as a fact, as it overlooks the candidate and campaign intensity factors noted in the previous paragraphs.

The next election will be decided by the relative level of support for candidates and parties at the time of the next election, and by the campaign fought on the new boundaries. Re-calculating the results of the 2001 election to match the new boundaries merely provides a guide to the key marginal seats where the next election is likely to be decided.

A note on Two-Candidate Preferred Counts at the 2001 Election

To win an electorate, a candidate must receive more than 50% of the vote after the distribution of preferences. The final distribution of preferences is performed by successively excluding candidates with the lowest primary vote and distributing that candidate's votes as preferences to other candidates remaining in the count. At the end of the count, the vote for the two final candidates is referred to as the 'two-candidate preferred vote'.

In most electorates, this will be the same as the 'two-party preferred vote', representing the final distribution of preferences between candidates representing the Labor Party, and the Liberal and National Party Coalition. In 46 electorates at the 2001 Western Australian election, the final two-candidate preferred count was also the two-party preferred count.

In the 11 electorates that did not finish as two-party contests, the Western Australian Electoral Commission conducted separate two-party preferred counts. In nine electorates, the choice of final two-party preferred candidates was straightforward. In Churchlands, Greenough, Moore, Nedlands, Pilbara and South Perth, counts were conducted between Labor and Liberal candidates. In Merredin, Roe and Wagin, the two-party count was between Labor and National Party candidates.

There was no Liberal Party candidate in Armadale, so the final two-candidate preferred count between the Labor candidate and Independent Rex Stubbs has been used as the surrogate two-party count. In Alfred Cove, no Labor candidate nominated, and a special count conducted between the Liberal candidate and Independent Denise Brailey has been used as the two-party contest.

While the formal distribution of preferences takes place for each electorate as a whole, the Western Australian Electoral Commission conducts the count in such a way that a two-party and two-candidate preferred count is available for each booth, and also for each category of declaration vote. These booth counts have been used in all calculations.

The new electorate summaries beginning on page 10 are derived from these two-party preferred counts by booth. Separate estimates based on two-candidate preferred counts can be found on page 40.

Calculating the Redistribution

Following the 2001 election, a database was prepared of the election results in each polling place. This database included both the primary and two-party preferred results. Two-candidate preferred counts have also been used where appropriate.

Decisions on transferring booths to new electorates have been made using the new maps provided by the Electoral Redistribution Commission. Where it appears that the catchment area for a polling place has been divided by a new boundary, results for that polling place have been split between the new electorates. A check has been made to ensure that the number of votes transferred correlates with the number of electors transferred, as in a report on enrolment transfers provided by the Commission.

Declaration votes have been distributed to new electorates in proportion to the number of electors transferred. For instance, 84.6% of electors in the electorate of Greenough remained in the re-drawn electorate of Greenough, while 15.4% were transferred to Geraldton. Declaration votes for Greenough, including normal votes cast at Perth Town Hall, have been distributed to each of the new electorates in the same proportion.

However, the relative proportion of votes transferred for each party have been weighted according to the vote in the booths transferred. As a first step, the ratio of declaration votes to booth votes in the old electorate was calculated, as in the following example.

These ratios were then applied to the votes transferred to new electorates. For instance several booths were transferred from Greenough to Geraldton. The number of voters transferred was 15.4% of the enrolment of Greenough, and so 15.4% of the Declaration votes have been transferred. The above ratios have been applied to the percentage party votes for the booths transferred, as shown below.

Greenough Transfers to Geraldton

In this case, the Labor vote in booths transferred to Geraldton was 25.64%, as opposed to 19.54% for the booths remaining in Greenough. Applying the ratio of 1.0542, the Labor percentage of Declaration votes to be transferred is 27.03%. After rounding so the percentages add to 100%, this becomes 27.12% of formal declaration votes. So of the 15.4% of declaration votes transferred to Geraldton, 27.12% will be Labor Party votes, as compared to the 21.56% Labor vote in the overall Declaration vote for Greenough.

This process may seem unduly complex, but it ensures that the declaration votes transferred reflect the political complexion of the areas involved. In the case of Greenough, the Declaration votes transferred to Geraldton will have a higher proportion of Labor votes than those that remain in Greenough. Overall, the sum of the declaration votes transferred to Geraldton and the new Greenough will equal the total declaration vote for the old Greenough.

Reading the Tables

Summaries of party vote for each new electorate can be found in tables beginning on page 10. The format for these summaries is explained in the following table.

The first line contains the name of the electorate, and the enrolment at the redistribution date of 11 February 2002. The first two columns contain total primary and two-party preferred votes and percentages, calculated by adding up the transferred booth and declaration votes.

The third column provides information on the votes transferred from the old electorates. In the case of Geraldton, it lists the number of votes transferred from Geraldton and Greenough. This is the total of the booth and declaration votes transferred, and includes both formal and informal votes. It is not the number of electors transferred.

The percentage figure on the right is the number of votes transferred expressed as a percentage of the number of electors transferred. In general, I have aimed to keep this figure around the same percentage as the relevant figure for each existing electorate. (A table comparing 2001 votes cast with electorate enrolments on 11 February 2002 can be found on page 45.) In general this percentage is kept in the range 85-95%. Where the value is outside of this range, "****" appears on the listing.

The detailed listings beginning on page 20 provide listings of booths transferred for each new electorate. Separate sub-totals are provided for votes transferred from each old electorate. Consider the following example from the listing for Geraldton.

The lines beginning "Transfers " indicates from which electorate votes have been transferred. The figure in brackets (11909) is the number of electors transferred from the old electorate of Geraldton, as provided by the Electoral Redistribution Commission.

In this example, the next two lines list the names of the polling places that have been transferred from the old electorate of Geraldton to the new. Where one of the transferred booths has been divided, as in the transfer of Geraldton Civic Centre where only 50% of the booth has been transferred from Greenough, a percentage figure is included next to the booth name. The percentage of Declaration votes transferred is indicated in the same way.

The column headed VOTES is the total votes transferred, and includes informal votes. It is not the sum of the formal votes on the line. Note that because of the small number of ballot papers with 'exhausted' preferences, there are minor discrepancies between the primary and two-party preferred vote totals. A total of votes and percentage votes for each party is provided, representing the sum of the booth and declaration votes transferred. A total is provided for each old electorate from which electors have been transferred, as well as a total vote for the new electorate.

Independent Held Seats

It is impossible to be certain of support for the four sitting Independent MPs in areas added to their electorates. An attempt has been made to calculate possible new margins for these seats, and details can be found on page 40. These estimates are highly speculative and should be treated with caution. Similar two-candidate estimates are also provided for the electorates that did not finish as two-party contests in 2001.

By-Elections

All calculations are based on 2001 election results. Results for the by-elections in Nedlands and Merredin have been ignored. Details of the by-elections can be found on page 46.

Acknowledgements and Disclaimer

All estimates have been calculated based on the actual results of the 2001 election and with reference to data and maps provided by the Electoral Redistribution Commission. Thanks go to the staff the Western Australian Electoral Commission, and the members and staff of the Electoral Redistribution Commission, for their assistance in preparing this publication. However, responsibility for all calculations, and the assumption underlying them, must rest with the author.

In the case of both Southern River and Yokine, only a minority of voters resided in both the new and the old electorates, and so it could be argued for instance that Thornlie has been re-named Southern River, and the old Southern River has been re-named Kenwick. However, as the names of both Southern River and Yokine have been retained, they are listed as continuing electorates.
