

## **Treasurers of Western Australia**

The Forest Government in 1890 was the first Government after Responsible Government was obtained. Frank Wilson was Treasurer in three separate governments, the Newton Moore Government in 1906-1910, Wilson Government 1910 - 1911 and the Wilson Government again in 1916 - 1917.
