

Lands Ministry of Western Australia

A Lands Ministry was first established in the Forrest Government the first Government after responsible government was obtained in 1890. Since then there have been 41 Ministers for Lands in 34 Governments. Sir James Mitchell was Minister for Lands in four different governments including his own.
