1. Short title

This is the *Appropriation (Consolidated Account) Act (No. 5) 2007.*

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation as follows:

- (a) sections 1 and 2 on the day on which this Act receives the Royal Assent;
- (b) the rest of the Act on the day after that day.

3. Appropriation for recurrent services and purposes

The sum of \$298 768 898.32, being payments of an extraordinary or unforeseen nature made under the authority of the *Financial Management Act 2006* and charged to the Consolidated Account under that Act, is appropriated for the recurrent services and purposes expressed in Schedule 1.
