
How will the recipients of this grant funding be determined?

Answer

The amount outlined in the 2018-19 Budget for Agriculture Research Grant Allocations of \$17.102 million is made up of the following items:

- DPIRD funded Grains Research and Development activity \$12.500 million this represents DPIRD funded Grains Research and Development activity currently under consideration.
- Red Imported Fire Ants Eradication Program \$2.146 million this is the State's contribution to the National eradication program.
- Australian Export Grains Innovation Centre (AEGIC) \$2,456 million this represents DPIRD's contribution to AEGIC.

- 2. I refer to Budget Paper No. 2, Volume 1, Division 16, Part 4, with reference to the 'Aboriginal Governance and Leadership Development Program' as it is listed in 'Details of Controlled Grants and Subsidies' table on page 201 and ask:
 - (a) why is the 2018-19 Budget Estimate half of the 2017-18 Estimated Actual;

Answer

The estimate reflects the budget balance of funds available for delivery under the multi-year Aboriginal Governance and Leadership Development Program (AGLDP).

(b) in what sectors of the program is funding being cut:

Answer

There is no funding being cut, it is the remaining balance of the \$2.3million allocated for delivery of the AGLDP

(i) if the cuts in funding are employment positions, how will the government fill the gap in the services these jobs provide; and

Answer

Not applicable.

- (c) due to their being no Forward Estimates beyond the 2018-19 Budget Estimate, is the government planning to abandon the program after this time:
 - (i) if yes, why; and

Answer

Consideration of investment and opportunities that will improve Aboriginal economic participation and development outcomes remain a focus of the Department and State government. The Aboriginal Governance and Leadership Development Program is a finite Royalties for Regions project that will be reviewed on completion.

A number of agencies play a role in this in this area and are progressing related initiatives. For example, the Department of Finance has initiated the State's first Aboriginal Procurement Policy commencing 1 July 2018. The Government has consulted with the Aboriginal business sector and Government agencies and identified a need to build capability within the sector to help Aboriginal businesses make the most of the opportunities available. Therefore, we have allocated \$500,000 a year in grants for the next three years to enhance expertise in business development, governance, contractual compliance and tendering.

Further investment and funding decisions will build on this and be considered across government and in a coordinated way through future budget processes.
