
## Q1 How do you purchase your vape nicotine liquids (all responses will be kept anonymous)?







### Q6 Which of the following age groups do you fall into?





### Q7 What gender are you?





## Q8 How do you follow Legalise Vaping Australia (LVA)? Tick all that apply.





## Q9 To what extent do you support or oppose the legalisation of the sale and purchase of personal vaporisers (vapes) or e-cigarettes in Australia?

















## Q16 In the future, how likely are you to support Legalise Vaping Australia financially via a donation?




