Legislation Committee: New Inquiry into the Residential Parks (Long-stay Tenants) Amendment Bill 2018

The Standing Committee on Legislation has commenced an inquiry into the Residential Parks (Long-stay Tenants) Amendment Bill 2018.

The Legislative Council referred the Bill to the Committee with the following terms of reference:

- 1. That the Residential Parks (Long-stay Tenants) Amendment Bill 2018 be discharged and referred to the Standing Committee on Legislation for consideration and report by no later than 21 March 2019; and
- 2. that the committee has the power to inquire into and report on the policy of the Bill.

The purpose of the Bill is to amend the *Residential Parks (Long-stay Tenants) Act 2006* to implement the recommendations of a statutory review of the Act.
