Legislation Committee Report into Residential Parks (Long-stay Tenants) Amendment Bill 2018

The Standing Committee on Legislation tabled its report on the Residential Parks (Long-stay Tenants) Amendment Bill 2018 in the Legislative Council today.

The Bill makes significant amendments to the *Residential Parks (Long-stay Tenants) Act 2006*. The amendments are intended to implement the recommendations of a statutory review of the Act. This is for the purpose of improving certainty of contract and fair dealings between park operators, existing and prospective long-stay tenants.

Overall, the Committee generally supports the policy of the Bill and believes the amendments strike a good balance between the interests of tenants and park operators.

The Committee has made findings and recommendations:

- seeking further information from the Government
- proposing amendments to some sections it believes will further improve the legislation
- clarifying the operation of some provisions of the Bill to address misunderstandings on their effect on tenants and park operators.
