## SYNOPSIS OF BILLS

*The following synopsis of Bills dealt with by the Legislative Assembly this week, is intended only to give a brief outline of the purpose of each Bill at the second reading stage of the Bill and the stages it was dealt with in the Legislative Assembly.*

### [Sentence Administration Amendment \(Monitoring Equipment\) Bill 2023](#)

(Attorney General) (No. 145)

The purpose of this bill is to amend the *Sentence Administration Act 2003*.

Second reading, debated and agreed.

Bill read a third time and forwarded to the Legislative Council.

### [Residential Tenancies Amendment Bill 2023](#)

(Minister for Housing) (No. 140)

The purpose of this bill is to amend the *Residential Tenancies Act 1987* and to make consequential amendments to the *Residential Parks (Long-stay Tenants) Act 2006*.

Second reading, debated and agreed.

Consideration in detail.

Bill read a third time and forwarded to the Legislative Council.

### [Firearms Bill 2024](#)

(Minister for Police) (No. 150)

The purpose of the bill is to provide for the control and regulation of firearms and related things; and to repeal the *Firearms Act 1973*; and to make consequential and related amendments to other Acts.

Introduced and read a first time.

Second reading speech delivered; debate adjourned.

### [Short-Term Rental Accommodation Bill 2024](#)

(Minister for Planning) (No. 147)

The purpose of the bill is to establish a scheme for the registration of short-term rental accommodation; and to provide for matters relating to information about short-term rental accommodation; and to make consequential amendments to the *Fair Trading Act 2010*; and to affect the operation of certain local laws; and for related purposes.

Introduced and read a first time.

Second reading speech delivered; debate adjourned.

[Conservation and Land Management Amendment Bill 2024](#)

(Minister for Environment) (No. 146)

The purpose of the bill is to amend the *Conservation and Land Management Act 1984*.

Introduced and read a first time.

Second reading speech delivered; debate adjourned.

[Land Tax Assessment Amendment \(Residential Construction Exemptions\) Bill 2023](#)

(Parliamentary Secretary to the Minister for Finance) (No. 141)

The purpose of the bill is to amend the *Land Tax Assessment Act 2002*.

Second reading debated and adjourned.

[Treasurer's Advance Authorisation Bill 2024](#)

(Treasurer) (No. 148)

The purpose of this bill is to authorise expenditure in the financial year ending on 30 June 2024 to make certain payments or to make advances for certain purposes.

Second reading debated and adjourned.

[Criminal Code Amendment Bill 2024](#)

(Attorney General) (No. 149)

The purpose of the bill is to amend The Criminal Code and to make consequential amendments to other Acts.

Introduced and read a first time.

Second reading speech delivered; debate adjourned.

[Road Traffic Legislation Amendment \(Infringement Management Reform\) Bill 2024](#)

(Treasurer) (No. 151)

The purpose of the bill is to amend the *Road Traffic (Administration) Act 2008*; and to amend the *Fines, Penalties and Infringement Notices Enforcement Act 1994*; and to make consequential and related amendments to other Acts.

Introduced and read a first time.

Second reading speech delivered; debate adjourned.

[Casino \(Burswood Island\) Agreement Amendment Bill 2023](#)

(Minister for Racing and Gaming) (No. 137)

The purpose of this bill is to amend the *Casino (Burswood Island) Agreement Act 1985*.
