I refer to Dongara Health Centre's use of generators during unplanned power outages, and I ask:

- (a) What is the capacity of the generators currently installed;
- (b) Are the generators sufficient to meet the peak load of the hospital infrastructure;
- (c) During hot weather when the generator is required, is it possible to run all the air conditioning and cooling units in the centre:
 - (i) Can the Minister confirm that all the air conditioning and cooling units in the centre were operating uninterrupted during recent power outages in the Midwest; and
