

NON-GOVERNMENT BUSINESS

1. Rights of Nature and Future Generations Bill 2019 (*Notice given 31 October 2019*)

Hon Diane Evers: To move —

That a Bill for "An Act to protect the rights of nature and future generations and for related purposes." be introduced and read a first time.

2. Environment Court Bill 2019 (Notice given 21 November 2019)

Hon Diane Evers: To move —

That a Bill for "An Act to establish the Environment Court and for incidental and related purposes." be introduced and read a first time.

3. Royalties for Regions Amendment Bill 2019 (*Notice given 22 November 2019*)

Hon Diane Evers: To move —

That a Bill for "An Act to amend the *Royalties for Regions Act 2009*." be introduced and read a first time.

4. Net Zero Greenhouse Gas Emissions in Western Australia

Hon Tim Clifford: to move —

That this House —

- (a) acknowledges the letter from 54 scientists, doctors and academics, urging the Parliament of Western Australia to enact a Zero Carbon Act to establish a binding target of net zero greenhouse gas emissions in Western Australia by 2050 and to implement shorter-term 'carbon budgets' for the State; and
- (b) calls on the McGowan Government to enshrine in legislation its own 'net zero emissions by 2050 aspiration', including setting interim targets and providing a clear pathway for how the target will be reached.

2. Petroleum and Geothermal Energy Resources (Hydraulic Fracturing) Amendment Regulations 2019 — Disallowance

That the *Petroleum and Geothermal Energy Resources (Hydraulic Fracturing) Amendment Regulations 2019* published in the Gazette on 6 September 2019 and tabled in the Legislative Council on 17 September 2019 under the *Petroleum and Geothermal Energy Resources Act 1967*, be and are hereby disallowed. (Tabled paper 3020).
