Message from His Excellency the Governor – Death of Queen Elizabeth II and Proclamation of King Charles III

Message No. 22 dated 11 September 2022 from His Excellency the Governor was reported as follows –

The Governor, with deep regret, formally informs the Legislative Assembly of official advice provided to him that Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth the Second passed away on 8 September 2022.

The Governor further informs the Legislative Assembly that His Majesty, King Charles the Third, has been proclaimed King of Australia and his other realms and Territories, and Head of the Commonwealth, as confirmed by the Governor in Executive Council on 11 September 2022.

Address of Condolence on the Death of Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II

The Premier, without notice, moved,

That the following Address be transmitted to His Excellency the Governor for presentation to His Majesty the King –

We, The Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia, express our deepest sympathy and condolences to Your Majesty on the death of your mother, Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, and give thanks for a remarkable life dedicated to service and duty

Question put and passed unanimously with members and officers of the Assembly standing in their places as a mark of respect.

Address of Congratulation on the Accession of His Majesty King Charles III
