**2772. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Local Government; Heritage; Culture and the Arts:**

I refer to Part 3, Subdivision 2 of the *Local Government Act 1995* (Local Laws made under any Act), and ask:

- (a) how many local laws are currently in existence;
- (b) does the Department of Local Government maintain a register of local laws:
  - (i) If not, why not;
- (c) have any councils failed to comply with section 3.16 of the Act, which requires councils to conduct a periodic review of local laws within 8 years:
  - (i) if yes, please list those councils that have failed to comply and the corresponding local law/s which have not been reviewed;
- (d) does a local law continue to have effect, if it has not been reviewed in accordance with section 3.16;
- (e) do Councils face any penalties, disciplinary action or otherwise if they fail to conduct reviews under section 3.16;
- (f) what actions does the Department undertake to ensure Councils comply with section 3.16 of the Act; and
- (g) should a Local Government's annual compliance audit detail any non-compliance with section 3.16?

**2774. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Local Government; Heritage; Culture and the Arts:**

Since 17 March 2017 has the Minister or any Ministerial staff had any contact with Councillor Dr Jemma Green, including, but not limited to: phone conversations, text messages, emails or other written correspondence and meetings, and if so:

- (a) what were the dates for each contact;
- (b) what was the nature of each contact;
- (c) where was each meeting held;
- (d) who was present at each meeting; and
- (e) what was discussed at each meeting?

**2775. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Local Government; Heritage; Culture and the Arts:**

Since 17 March 2017 has the Minister or any Ministerial staff had any contact with the Acting Chief Executive Officer of the City of Perth, Martin Mileham, including, but not limited to: phone conversations, text messages, emails or other written correspondence and meetings, and if so:

**2776. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Local Government; Heritage; Culture and the Arts:**

Since May 2015, has the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries (or the former Department of Local Government and Communities) been contacted by or met with the City of Perth with any concerns or comments regarding governance issues, bullying, the stability/functioning of the Council and/or the safety of the work environment and if so:

- (a) what were the dates for each contact or meeting;
- (b) what was the nature of each contact or meeting;
- (c) where was each meeting held;
- (d) who was present at each meeting;
- (e) what was discussed at each meeting; and
- (f) what support or assistance was provided by the Department to the Council, on what date/s?

**2777. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Local Government; Heritage; Culture and the Arts:**

I refer to the administrative response issued by the City of Perth on 1 March 2018, which states 'Where it was deemed Elected Members had not met the appropriate standard of professional conduct, all instances were reported to the Department of Local Government and Communities', and ask:

- (a) how many referrals were made to the Department;
- (b) on what date was each referral made;
- (c) who, within the council, made each referral;
- (d) which elected members were referred to the Department;
- (e) on how many occasions was each elected member referred to the Department;
- (f) what inquiries has the Department made in respect of each referral;
- (g) what action, disciplinary or otherwise, has taken place in respect of each referral; and
- (h) when were you first made aware of this matter?

**2778. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Commerce and Industrial Relations:**

Since 1 January 2015 has WorkSafe had any contact from, or meetings with, the City of Perth and if so:

- (a) what were the dates for each meeting or contact;
- (b) what was the nature of each meeting or contact;
- (c) where was each meeting held;
- (d) who was present at each meeting;
- (e) what was discussed at each meeting; and
- (f) what actions have been taken by Worksafe to ensure the City of Perth is a safe workplace?

**2779. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Local Government; Heritage; Culture and the Arts:**

I refer to the recent issues at the City of Perth and ask:

- (a) when did the Minister first become aware of the involvement of Worksafe with the City of Perth;
- (b) when was the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries first notified of the involvement of Worksafe with the City of Perth; and
- (c) what actions have been taken, or support offered by the Department to ensure the City of Perth is a safe workplace?

**2780. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Local Government; Heritage; Culture and the Arts:**

Since 17 March 2017, on how many occasions has the City of Perth sought advice from the Department of Local Government, and for each occasion:

- (a) what was the reason advice was sought and the date of that request;
- (b) was the advice sought by an elected official or an employee of the City of Perth; and
- (c) what response was provided by the Department?

**2781. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Culture and the Arts:**

I refer to the comments in the 'Western Australian Public Libraries: Our Future', Background Paper that there is the potential to disaggregate the State Records Office (SRO) from its current administrative placement in the State Library of Western Australia, due to its alignment with the direction of digital transformation of Government information led by the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer, and ask:

- (a) why are you considering a further move of the SRO;
- (b) how would such a move benefit the state;
- (c) how does such a move reconcile with the benefits of a combined service for heritage materials;
- (d) is consideration being given to splitting the heritage and recordkeeping functions of the SRO; and
- (e) will the SRO and State Records Commission be consulted before any such move is considered?

**2782. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Culture and the Arts:**

I refer to the State Records Commission Annual Report 2016-2017 which states 'A small number of transfers of State archives were completed in 2016-17... A further 17 consignments of State archives are ready and awaiting transfer whilst 47 more consignments have been identified and requested from the State Library. These proposed transfers are yet to be finalized and the State Records Office (SRO) is closely monitoring progress. The Commission notes that a consistent momentum of transfer is yet to be achieved' and ask:

- (a) why has a consistent momentum of transfer not yet been achieved;
- (b) why hasn't the move of the SRO into a directorate of the State Library of Western Australia not facilitated a closer working relationship; and
- (c) how many transfers were made from the State Library of Western Australia to the SRO for each of the past 5 financial years?

**2783. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Culture and the Arts:**

For each of the past ten financial years, on how many occasions has the State Records Office accepted emergency transfers of State archives from government agencies?

**2784. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Culture and the Arts:**

I refer to the State Records Commission Annual Report 2016-2017 and ask:

- (a) when will the final version of the Born Digital Strategy be released;
- (b) how are government agencies currently managing their digital records and assets; and
- (c) what is being done to address the lack of appropriate infrastructure for both digital archives?

**2785. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Culture and the Arts:**

I refer to the State Records Commission Annual Report 2016-2017 which states that the State Records Office (SRO) has been unable to accept the transfer of archives from agencies since 2001 and raises concerns about the potential loss or damage to more than 56.5 linear kilometres of hard copy state archives, and I ask:

- (a) what is being done to address this issue;
- (b) has any additional funding been allocated to address this issue; and
- (c) is the recently created Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries supportive of the endeavours of the SRO to meet its functions and obligations?

**2786. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Culture and the Arts:**

I refer to the comments made by the Director General of the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries during Estimates on 19 September 2017 that the move of the State Records Office (SRO) into a directorate of the State Library of Western Australia will help to deal with matters related to the conservation of archival records, and ask:

- (a) what improvement in the conservation of the state archives has been undertaken since the change;
- (b) what conservation services were provided by the State Library of Western Australia to the SRO, prior to its move;
- (c) what additional conservation services are now being provided by the State Library of Western Australia to the SRO, since its move; and
- (d) how much additional funding has been provided to the State Library of Western Australia to provide the additional conservation services to the SRO?

**2787. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Culture and the Arts:**

- (1) Will the State Records Office and its role within directorate of the State Library of Western Australia be considered as part of the strategic review?
- (2) If no to (1), why not?

**2788. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Culture and the Arts:**

I note the comments made by the Director General and the Minister that the placement of the State Records Office (SRO) within a directorate of the State Library of WA is an administrative change only, and ask:

- (a) what is the likely impact on the independence of the SRO if a single workforce of specialist positions is created;
- (b) how can this be supported if the change is purely administrative, and there is no change to the *State Records Act 2000* or the *Library Board Act 1951*;
- (c) what sharing of digital collections systems and physical service locations has taken place since the change; and
- (d) has any training been provided to staff since the amalgamation, and if yes, what training was provided and how was it delivered?

**2789. Mr A. Krsticevic to the Minister for Culture and the Arts:**

I refer to the comments made by the Director General of the Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries during Estimates on 19 September 2017, that the move of the State Records Office (SRO) into a directorate of the State Library will provide additional administrative support to the SRO and ask:

- (a) what additional administrative services or support are now provided to the SRO;
- (b) why was this administrative support not previously available;
- (c) what advantages to the State and/or SRO have been identified and documented since the administrative change; and
- (d) how will these benefits be documented, measured and reported going forward?
