9. Message from the Legislative Council

Message No. 124 dated 21 May 2020 from the Legislative Council was reported as follows –

The Legislative Council acquaints the Legislative Assembly that in response to Legislative Assembly Message No. 188, the Legislative Council passed the following resolution –

- (a) That in response to Legislative Assembly Message No. 188, the Legislative Council agrees to the Legislative Assembly's resolution for the establishment of a Joint Select Committee into Palliative Care in Western Australia subject to the following amendments to which the Legislative Council seeks the concurrence of the Legislative Assembly:
 - (i) Delete the words in paragraph 4 and insert –
That the Standing Orders of the Legislative Council relating to standing and select committees will be followed as far as they can be applied.
 - (ii) Insert new paragraph 8 –
That the Member for Thornlie be appointed Chair of the Committee and that the Hon Nick Goiran be appointed Deputy Chair of the Committee.
- (b) That subject to the Legislative Assembly agreeing to the amendments, the following Legislative Council Members be appointed to the Joint Select Committee:

- (i) Hon Nick Goiran;
- (ii) Hon Kyle McGinn;
- (iii) Hon Alison Xamon.

Ordered, That consideration in detail of Legislative Council Message No. 124 be made an Order of the Day for the next sitting of the Assembly.
