## GUIDELINES ON ENROLMENT 2010

**Introduction**

The facility at City Beach Residential College is being used to provide accommodation for Gifted and Talented Education students. This arrangement commenced in 2007.

It had been planned that in 2009 a new boarding facility for gifted and talented education students would be established on the Perth Modern School campus.

**Gifted and Talented residential facility**

The boarding service is for secondary school students aged 12 to 17.

It will provide for students turning 18, but only if they are willing to abide by the conditions of enrolment applying to students aged 17.

Academically talented students, identified through the formal assessment processes and offered places at Perth Modern School, will be given first priority.

Students identified through the assessment and offered places in other metropolitan Gifted and Talented programs will have next priority, according to their selection ranking.

**Enrolment Priority**

1. Gifted and Talented students attending Perth Modern School according to their ranking as established by the Executive Director, School Support Programs.
2. Gifted and Talented students attending other Gifted and Talented programs according to their ranking as established by the Executive Director, School Support Programs.
3. Perth Modern School students who need to board away from home as verified by the Principal. These will be considered on a case-by-case basis and also endorsed by the relevant Director Schools.\*

\*Third priority is given to Perth Modern School students on the understanding that this will be an interim arrangement and that in 2011 the only students attending Perth Modern School will be Gifted and Talented students.
