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ANNUAL REPORT 2009

INTRODUCTION

The Land Surveyors Licensing Board of Western Australia (the Board) is constituted under Section 4 of the *Licensed Surveyors Act 1909* (the Act). In accordance with Section 25C of the Act the Board has prepared the following report of its activities for the year ending 31 December 2009.

THE BOARD

The Board consisted of six members comprising the Surveyor General ex officio, two members nominated by the Surveyor General, two members nominated by the WA Division of the Institution of Surveyors Australia and one member nominated by Curtin University as the approved tertiary education institution offering a relevant undergraduate course in surveying.

CHARTER OF THE BOARD

During 2009, The Board undertook a comprehensive review of its charter responsibilities:

Recognising that land boundary certainty is essential to a secure sustainable and cost effective land tenure system, the community is entitled to the highest confidence in the training, qualification, skill and accountability of land surveyors.

The responsibility for delivering this entitlement resides with the Land Surveyors Licensing Board of Western Australia.

To meet this responsibility to the community of Western Australia the Board has established three objectives:

- To ensure that the education and training of licensed land surveyors statewide is demonstrably able to meet the community expectations of the land titling system.
- To ensure that the practice standards of licensed land surveyors meet the expectation and requirements of the community and the registering authority.
- To provide a fair, open and accessible process to deal with complaints against licensed land surveyors to the extent that the

occurrence and impact of breaches of the Licensed Surveyors Act are minimised.

To achieve these objectives the Board will effectively engage with government, industry, education and the community through the processes of:

- Setting and monitoring education standards of candidates seeking registration as licensed surveyors.
- Setting and monitoring training requirements of candidates for registration as licensed surveyors.
- Demonstrating the adequacy of education and training through the process of examination.
- Setting and monitoring standards for the continuous professional development of land surveyors
- Consultatively developing and regulating standards to enable land surveyors' practices to meet community and registering requirements
- Acting in the community interest when breaches of Acts and Regulations are found.
- Maintaining reciprocity of registration throughout Australia and New Zealand.

TRAINING and REGISTRATION

As at December 31 2009, there were 619 licensed surveyors on the register. The complete register is included in this report as 'Appendix C' and can be inspected and downloaded from the Board's website at www.lslb.wa.gov.au .

248 of the licensed surveyors hold a current practising certificate.

246 of the practising licensed surveyors are resident in Western Australia.

During 2009, Three (3) surveyors were added to the register, one (1) by way of practical examination and two (2) by way of letter of accreditation from a reciprocating Board. (This number is the lowest for some years and is commented upon in "General Trends")

As at December 31 2009, there were thirty (30) Professional Training agreements registered by the Board. Seven (7) new agreements were registered in 2009. Two (2) agreements were cancelled by mutual consent.

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GENERAL

TRENDS

Section 25C (1a) of the Licensed Surveyors Act 1909 directs the board to report any trends, special problems and forecasts that have emerged in the reporting year or the coming year.

In the experience of the members of the Board, the workload on Licensed Surveyors has increased since 2007/8. The effects of the global financial crisis are still evident to the extent that medium to large-scale land developments are still being adversely effected. Many surveyors have allocated land development staff to mining construction projects to ensure employment continuity. The by-product of this reallocation of staff has been reduced cadastral training opportunities for graduates.

To maintain the community confidence that both it and the Land Surveyors it registers are able to continue to meet the challenge of community expectation land boundary certainty the Board has carried out an in-depth strategic review of its charter and processes and the value of a regulated profession to our community (appendix B).

The reviewed charter and processes have formed the framework of this report.

The Board and Landgate have continued with the memorandum of understanding by which Landgate provides a full time Secretary located in a separate office that is readily accessible to the public and is clearly seen as an independent body. The Board believes this arrangement continues to enhance the effective administration of the Act and thanks Mr Mike Bradford the Chief Executive of Landgate, Surveyor General and Board

member for this commitment and the ongoing assistance of Landgates' professional officers.

Two long serving members of the Board chose to announce their retirements at the end of 2009.

At its December meeting the Board will recognise the outstanding contributions of two retiring members. Section "S26 (ia)" of the Licensed Surveyors Act allows for the recognition of Licensed Surveyors who have contributed to the profession of surveying. Such an award to **Neil Browne** and **Barry Cribb** is most appropriate, accordingly under that section; **Neil** and **Barry** are to be awarded the status of "**Licensed Surveyor Emeritus**".



Neil was first elected to the Board in 2000 as a representative of the members of the Institution of Surveyors WA and this now marks his ninth and final year of Board membership. In 2005 Neil was elected the first non government Chairman of the Board since its establishment in 1886. The five years of Neil's chairmanship have seen the biggest single change to disciplinary procedures in the 100 year history of the *Licensed Surveyors Act 1909*, with the establishment of the State Administrative Tribunal. Both the community and practising land

surveyors of this state have been well served by Neil's commitment of his expertise, his practicality and a unique ability to quickly and calmly analyse evolving issues, foster a consensus and then articulately communicate the position to the many stakeholders relying on the effectiveness of the Board.

Barry joined the Board in 1989 as the nominee of the Chief Executive of the then Department of Land Administration (now Landgate). 2009 is Barry's twenty first year of Board membership and having recently taken his leave of Landgate will step down at the end of this year when his term ends. Barry has made an outstanding contribution during a time of transformation for the Board, Landgate and the practising surveyor; Accreditation, annual practising certificates, continuing professional development and self-assessment were very significant evolutions and their successful implementation is due in no small measure to Barry's commitment to the integrity of the cadastral survey system.



It can be concluded that the benefits enjoyed by Western Australians of one of the most secure land titling systems in the world, are due in great measure to the vigilant stewardship of Land Surveyors Licensing Board members such as Neil and Barry encouraging and supporting the professionalism of the land surveyors registered by the board.

The community's expectations of positional certainty are fundamental to the fair, accessible, transparent, efficient and secure land administration system necessary for our community to prosper. The fundamental outcome of the land registration system for everybody is certainty in the knowledge of who owns the land, what other parties have an interest in it and where it is located. That the purchaser of a property can have confidence that the details specified on the survey plan and reflected in the Certificate of Title correspond to those actually marked out on the ground is due significantly to the professional dedication of surveyors such as Neil Browne and Barry Cribb.

Accordingly, by this resolution, the Board declares Neil and Barry each to be a **LICENSED SURVEYOR EMERITUS**, presents an appropriate certificate and includes this resolution into the minutes of the meeting and the honour roll of the annual report of the Board



**Notes to the Financial Statements
For the year ended 31 December 2009**

Note 1: Statement of Significant Accounting Policies

This financial report is a special purpose financial report prepared for use by directors and members of the company. The directors have determined that the company is not a reporting entity.

The report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the following Australian Accounting Standards.

AASB 1031: Materiality
AASB 110: Events after the Balance Sheet Date

No other Australian Accounting Standards or other authoritative pronouncements of the Australian Accounting Standards Board have been applied.

The financial report has been prepared on an accruals basis and is based on historic costs and does not take into account changing money values, or except where specifically stated, current valuations of non-current assets.

The following specific accounting policies, which are consistent with the previous period unless otherwise stated, have been adopted in the preparation of this financial report:

(a) Property, Plant and Equipment

Property, plant and equipment are carried at cost, independent of directors' valuation. All assets, excluding freehold land and buildings, are depreciated over their useful lives to the company.

(b) Inventories

Inventories are measured at the lower of cost and net realisable value. Costs are assigned on a first-in first-out basis and include direct materials, direct labour and an appropriate proportion of variable and fixed overhead expenses.

Note 2: Events Subsequent to Reporting Date

Since the end of the financial year, there are no subsequent events that need to be brought in the accounts at 31 December 2009.

APPENDIX B

A Regulated Profession

An analysis of the value to the community of Western Australia of a statutorily regulated land surveying profession.

Recognising that the significance and importance of land to our society is self-evident. In ours, like all other countries, land is the most fundamental of resources. It is the basis of food and other primary production; it is the basis of our shelter; it supports secondary and even tertiary industry, and for many it has a spiritual quality being the space needed for personal, familial and community action and interaction. The notion of personal dignity and empowerment is often enshrined in the extent to which the state recognises that legitimate occupation.

Recognising that this recognition relies on a system of plans and diagrams based on physical survey is critically important. This system is known as the cadastre and surveyors undertaking cadastral surveys must be registered by the Land Surveyors Licensing Board. The objectives of the Licensed Surveyors Act in maintaining the integrity of the cadastre go principally toward ensuring the certainty of position the community takes for granted and relies on.

The benefits enjoyed by Western Australians of arguably one of the most secure land titling systems in the world, are due in great measure to the vigilant stewardship of the Land Surveyors Licensing Board and the professionalism of the land surveyors registered by the board.

This is confirmed by The Department of Land Administration's (now Landgate) review of the Licensed Surveyors Act 1909 for the National Competition Policy Review:

"The cadastral surveyor defines the size, location and boundaries of each land parcel in the State's cadastre and consequently plays a prime role in its continuing accuracy. The skill of the surveyor is critical to the ongoing integrity of this major information system used by government and the community. Every cadastral survey to determine or re-establish land property boundaries is based on surveys of the past. Under Western Australia's strictly regulated system today's surveyor can rely with a considerable degree of certainty on the accuracy of this previous work. Over time the accuracy of the licensed surveyors' work is crucial to ongoing protection of the State's 'guarantee' of Title encapsulated within the Torrens Title system."

Demonstrated by the absence of the requirement for Title Insurance that is mandatory in many developed countries. In the United States title insurance to give protection to the lender typically costs the owner **0.8%** of the mortgage amount. If this figure was applied to mortgages registered in Western Australia in 2007/08 - an amount of **\$69.3 billion** for 88 000 mortgages the premiums would amount to **\$554,000,000** or \$6300 per mortgagee.

As can be demonstrated, the diligence of the Land Surveyors Licensing Board leads directly to the saving of a minimum of \$190,000,000 ($\frac{1}{3}$) of the premium component should title insurance become a prerequisite for the community in real property transactions.

A strong case, supported by published evidence, exists that Land Surveyors Licensing Board is essential to the integrity of the land administration system of this State; it must continue to be mandated accordingly and adequately resourced by the Government on behalf of the people.
