## **ANNUAL REPORT 2010**

### **INTRODUCTION**

The Land Surveyors Licensing Board of Western Australia (the Board) is constituted under Section 4 of the *Licensed Surveyors Act 1909* (the Act). In accordance with Section 25C of the Act the Board has prepared the following report of its activities for the year ending 31 December 2010.

### **THE BOARD**

The Board has six members. The Surveyor General is ex officio and nominates one member with registration expertise. The WA Division of the Institution of Surveyors Australia nominates two members. The Minister nominates a member to represent the interests of the consumers of surveyor's services and one member is nominated by Curtin University as the approved tertiary education institution offering a relevant undergraduate course in surveying.

### **CHARTER OF THE BOARD**

During 2010, The Board continued its comprehensive review of its charter responsibilities:

Recognising that land boundary certainty is essential to a secure sustainable and cost effective land tenure system, the community is entitled to the highest confidence in the training, qualification, skill and accountability of land surveyors.

The responsibility for delivering this entitlement resides with the Land Surveyors Licensing Board of Western Australia.

To meet this responsibility to the community of Western Australia the Board has established three objectives:

- To ensure that the education and training of licensed land surveyors state-wide is demonstrably able to meet the community expectations of the land titling system.
- To ensure that the practice standards of licensed land surveyors meet the expectation and requirements of the community and the registering authority.
- To provide a fair, open and accessible process to deal with complaints against licensed land surveyors to the extent that the

occurrence and impact of breaches of the Licensed Surveyors Act are minimised.

To achieve these objectives the Board will effectively engage with government, industry, education and the community through the processes of:

- Setting and monitoring education standards of candidates seeking registration as licensed surveyors.
- Setting and monitoring training requirements of candidates for registration as licensed surveyors.
- Demonstrating the adequacy of education and training through the process of examination.
- Setting and monitoring standards for the continuous professional development of land surveyors
- Consultatively developing and regulating standards to enable land surveyors' practices to meet community and registering requirements
- Acting in the community interest when breaches of Acts and Regulations are found.
- Maintaining reciprocity of registration throughout Australia and New Zealand.

## **TRAINING and REGISTRATION**

As at December 31 2010, there were 626 licensed surveyors on the register. The complete register is included in this report as 'Appendix B' and can be inspected and downloaded from the Board's website at [www.lslb.wa.gov.au](http://www.lslb.wa.gov.au) .

258 of the licensed surveyors hold a current practising certificate.

253 of the practising licensed surveyors are resident in Western Australia.

During 2010, seven surveyors were added to the register, three by way of practical examination and four by way of letter of accreditation from a reciprocating Board.

As at December 31 2010, there were thirty-four Professional Training agreements registered by the Board. Ten new agreements were registered in 2010. Six agreements were cancelled by mutual consent.

## **GENERAL**

### **100 YEARS OF THE ACT**

The Licensed Surveyors Act 1909 came into effect on January 1<sup>st</sup> 1910. In these 100 years of operation, this regulated profession has delivered land boundary certainty to the community of Western Australia.

The 1909 Act was the outcome of various inter-colonial and dominion conferences of Surveyors General and Survey Boards beginning in the early 1890's. Each dominion, colony and territory developed legislative recommendations to develop common practices to support land boundary surveys and the mutual recognition of licensed surveyors between all the colonies and New Zealand. This establishment of the reciprocating surveyor's boards of Australia and New Zealand came into effect in 1892. In addition to establishing reciprocity of qualifications, this conference also established the time zones for Australia and that the unit of length will be the English unit as provided by English Statute law.

Since 1892 the guiding principles of the Boards have been:

That there will be a Board in each colony.

The examination of surveyors shall be consistent across all colonies and dominions.

Only surveyors licensed by the Board shall carry out land surveys under the Transfer of Land Act and the Land Act in each colony.

Crown survey boundaries as marked on the ground are unalterable and deed will be amended to reflect this.

To mark this centenary and to continue to ensure that the practice of land surveyors meets community requirements, The Board prepared a comprehensive "Terms of Engagement" template for land surveyors and their clients.

This template uses plain language to establish the terms of engagement between a licensed surveyor and a client. The client has the benefit of having a comprehensive statement of what will be done, when it will be done and how much it is likely to cost. The client is made aware of the licensed surveyor's statutory obligations to the government and the community and should the need arise a dispute resolution procedure is identified.

## **TRENDS**

Section 25C (1a) of the *Licensed Surveyors Act 1909* directs the board to report any trends, special problems and forecasts that have emerged in the reporting year or the coming year.

The effects of the global financial crisis are still evident to the extent that medium to large-scale land developments are only slowly recovering from 2008. Many surveyors have continued to allocate land development staff to mining construction projects to ensure employment continuity. The by-product of this reallocation of staff has been an extension in the time graduate surveyors are taking to meet cadastral training obligations. Although there has been an extension in training time the number of graduate surveyors in training has risen. There is some evidence to suggest that the first wave of "baby-boomers" is planning retirement and firms are actively increasing training as part of succession planning.

The mining industry continues to draw new graduates with the result that the age of entrants into professional training agreements is often in late twenties to early thirties. The Department of Spatial Sciences at Curtin University reports the number of fourth year students undertaking the unit "Professional Cadastral Practice" is rising significantly, this unit is a preparation for entry in a professional training agreement and Board looks forward to a further significant rise in the number of graduates in training.

The Board and Landgate have continued with the memorandum of understanding by which Landgate provides a full time Secretary located in a separate office that is readily accessible to the public and is seen as an independent body. The Board believes this arrangement continues to enhance the effective administration of the Act and thanks Mr Mike Bradford the Chief Executive of Landgate, Surveyor General and Board member for this commitment and the ongoing assistance of Landgates' professional officers.



**Note 1: Summary of Significant Accounting Policies**

The members have prepared the financial statements on the basis that the association is a non-reporting entity because there are no users dependant on general purpose financial statements. The financial statements are therefore special purpose financial statements that have been prepared in order to meet the needs of the members.

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the significant accounting policies disclosed below, which the members have determined are appropriate to meet the needs of the members. Such accounting policies are consistent with the previous period unless stated otherwise.

The financial statements has been prepared on an accruals basis and are based on historical costs unless otherwise stated in the notes. The accounting policies that have been adopted in the preparation of the statements are as follows:

**(a) Provisions**

Provisions are recognised when the company has a legal or constructive obligation, as a result of past events, for which it is probable that an outflow of economic benefits will result and that outflow can be reasonably measured.

Provisions recognised represent the best estimate of the amounts required to settle the obligation at reporting date.

**(b) Revenue and Other Income**

Revenue is measured at the value of the consideration received or receivable after taking into account any trade discounts and volume rebates allowed. For this purpose, deferred consideration is not discounted to present values when recognising revenue.

Interest revenue is recognised using the effective interest rate method, which, for floating rate financial assets, is the rate inherent in the instrument. Dividend revenue is recognised when the right to receive a dividend has been established.

Revenue recognised related to the provision of services is determined with reference to the stage of completion of the transaction at the reporting date and where outcome of the contract can be estimated reliably.
