Extension of reporting date for JSCCCC inquiry

On 16 June 2011 I wrote to advise that the Committee had resolved to extend the reporting date of an inquiry into how the Corruption and Crime Commission deals with allegations and notifications of WA Police misconduct until 1 March 2012, so that due consideration could be given to the CCC investigation into the tasering of Mr Kevin Spratt, which is particularly relevant to the inquiry but was not anticipated to be reported until later in the year.

I advise further that on 7 September 2011 the Committee resolved to extend the reporting dates of an inquiry into whether the Corruption and Crime Commission should have the jurisdiction to recover proceeds of crime and unexplained wealth to 29 March 2012.

In respect to the second of these inquiries I advise that due to unforseen emergence of a number of other pressing matters that have required urgent Committee attention over the past months, the Committee will now report to Parliament on its inquiry into whether the Corruption and Crime Commission should have the jurisdiction to recover proceeds of crime and unexplained wealth on 21 June 2012.

In respect to the first inquiry I advise that the aforementioned report is still yet to be tabled by the CCC and accordingly a report to Parliament on the Committee's inquiry into how the Corruption and Crime Commission deals with allegations and notifications of WA Police misconduct, will be made on 15 November 2012.
