## **LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1995**

REPEAL LOCAL LAW 2011

Under the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1995* and under all other powers enabling it, the Council of the City of Fremantle resolved on 24 August 2011 to make the following local law—

## ARRANGEMENT

## PART 1—PRELIMINARY

### 1. Citation

This local law may be cited as the City of Fremantle Repeal Local Law 2011.

#### 2. Commencement

This local law comes into operation 14 days after the date of its publication in the *Government Gazette*.

## 3. Purpose and effect

- (1) The purpose of this local law is to repeal two of the City of Fremantle's local laws.
- (2) The effect of this local law is to repeal obsolete and outdated local laws relating to the district of the City of Fremantle.

# 4. Repeal

The following local laws are repealed—

- (a) Local law—Regulating and controlling stormwater drainage affecting the city's street systems as published in the *Government Gazette* on **6 April 2001** including amendments.
- (b) Local law—Street lawns and gardens as published in the *Government Gazette* on **11 December 2001** including amendments.
