## QUESTION WITHOUT NOTICE (Of which some notice has been given)

## Thursday, 17 May 2012

Hon Sue Ellery to the Minister for Energy.

I refer to the Minister's answer to QON 7528 in the other place and the confirmation in that answer, that Western Power paid \$500,446 in Fringe Benefits Tax in 2010-11 for entertainment, and I ask:

- 1. Can the Minister confirm:
  - a. That this tax payment was in respect of \$521,251 in entertainment expenses; and
  - b. If no to (1) (a), what was the exact amount paid in entertainment expenses?
- 2. Will the Minister detail each of the entertainment items that comprised this amount of money and if not why not?

## Answer

- (1)(a) Yes
- (b) Not applicable.
- (2) The expenditure of \$521,251 can be broken down into two categories, as follows:

Meals and venue hire:

\$372,624

Recreation:

\$148,627

It should be noted that discretionary expenditure at Western Power has reduced from \$10.9 million in 2008/2009 to \$8.8 million in the current financial year, a reduction of 18.8%.

One should consider Western Power's expenditure on entertainment in the context of overall operating expenditure of almost \$1.2 billion and across a corporation of more than 3,329 employees. In other words, \$521,251 represents about 0.04% of overall expenditure at Western Power.
