Dear Chairman

Thank you for your correspondence dated 1 March 2012, regarding Report No 8 of the Joint Standing Committee for Children and Young People, Report on the functions of the Commissioner for Children and Young People: Working with Children Checks, which was tabled in Parliament in March 2012.

Recommendations one and three have been referred to the Statutory Review of the Working with Children (Criminal Record Checking) Act 2004 (the Act) for consideration as part of that Review. I expect to receive the Review Report for my consideration in June or July this year. I will then table my report to both Houses of Parliament as required by section 47 of the Act.

With regard to recommendation two, I consider that it is a matter for the independent Auditor General to determine whether a specific audit is required into working with children checks for departmental staff.

I also note that the Committee's amended Report No 9 was tabled in Parliament late last week. I will ensure that this report is also made available to the review.

Thank you for the opportunity to respond to the report.
