

Cremation Amendment Regulations 2014

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Cremation Amendment Regulations 2014*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) the rest of the regulations — on the day after that day.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Cremation Regulations 1954*.
