\* The variation in the number of clients serviced by LAMP is due to a change in their service delivery model, reflecting a shift from group information sessions to individual personalised support service. Although the number of clients has reduced, service contact hours have increased which is in line with a personalised support service model. The previous service model involved presenting support information to large numbers of school community members including students, staff and families. The current service model focuses on small individual service delivery, for example working with individuals one-on-one in the community.
