Notes

- 1. The National Standards for Student Attendance Data Reporting (endorsed by the former Standing Council on School Education and Early Childhood) prescribes Semester 1 data as the only reporting period for student attendance data collection.
- 2. 2014 Semester 1 attendance data is not yet available. These data are subject to quality assurance and validation checks, which take 6 to 8 weeks to complete. Attendance data are not released until the Director General and Minister have been appropriately briefed.
- 3. In 2013 the calculation of student attendance was changed to meet an agreed national standard. From 2013 Semester 1 student attendance data includes all school enrolments that occurred during the semester. Prior to this only students enrolled at the end of the semester were considered.
- 4. In 2013 Pre-primary was included for the first time as it became the first year of compulsory schooling.
- 5. Because of these changes, direct comparison of Semester 1, 2013 student attendance and previous collections should not be made.
- 6. The revised student attendance calculation from Semester 1, 2013 is calculated on the basis of students' entire enrolment record. This means that a significant number of students appear, pro rata, in multiple schools. For this reason, the columns providing student numbers for 2013 should not be aggregated as they will be greater than the total number of students.
- 7. The Department reports student attendance in relation to three 'at risk' categories. These are less than 60%, 60% to less than 80% and 80% to less than 90%. These categories have been used in response to this request. Regular attendance (not reported here) is from 90% to 100%.
