

LC QON 1588 – Tabled Paper

1. The WA Country Health Service (WACHS) – South West provides the following public mental health services in the Warren/Blackwood and Vasse districts:

- Community Adult Mental Health Services.
- Child and Adolescent Mental Health Community Services.
- Older Adult Mental Health Services.

Residents of Warren/Blackwood and Vasse also have access to the Bunbury Hospital Inpatient Mental Health Unit.

Additionally, Table 1 below outlines the non-government organisations commissioned by the Mental Health Commission (MHC) to provide community mental health support services in the Warren/Blackwood and Vasse districts in the 2014/15 financial year.

2. Locations of WACHS – South West public mental health services in the Warren/Blackwood and Vasse districts are:

- Bridgetown
- Manjimup
- Margaret River
- Busselton

3. For the 2014/15 financial year, the State Government budget allocation for WACHS – South West public mental health services and non-government organisations providing community mental health support is \$26,729,031. (Note: WACHS – South West Mental Health is a regional service).
