

## **Enrolment-linked base allocation**

The enrolment-linked base allocation is provided to ensure schools are able to meet general operating costs.

The allocation depends on the type of school and the size of the student population. The allocation reduces to zero once the per student funding generates sufficient funding to meet general operating costs.

#### **Enrolment-linked base allocation**



In 2015 the allocation will be according to five broad classifications:

### **Enrolment-linked base allocation 2015 for school types and sizes:**

Primary school		
School type: Early childhood, junior primary school, primary school		
Enrolments	Allocation per school	
0 – 100	Between \$300,000 and \$400,000	
100 – 200	\$400,000	
200 – 600	Reducing from \$400,000 to \$0	
600 and above	\$0	
For example, a primary school with 50 students would receive an enrolment-linked		
base allocation of \$350,000.		
Secondary school		
School type: High school, senior high school, senior college		
Enrolments	Allocation	
0 – 100	Increasing from \$650,000 to \$750,000	
100 – 500	\$750,000	
500 – 1200	Reducing from \$750,000 to \$0	
1200 and above	\$0	

For example, a secondary school with 400 students would receive an enrolment-linked base allocation of \$750,000.

#### Combined school

School type: District high school, K-12 school

Tailored for each school depending on the split of primary and secondary students, with a maximum enrolment-linked base allocation of \$600,000 if all students are primary students and \$750,000 if all students are secondary students.

Enrolments	Allocation
If 100% primary students:	
0 – 100	Increasing from \$500,000 to \$600,000
100 – 350	\$600,000
350 – 900	Reducing from \$600,000 to \$0
900 and above	\$0
If 100% secondary students:	
0 – 100	Increasing from \$650,000 to \$750,000
100 – 350	\$750,000
350 – 900	Reducing from \$750,000 to \$0
900 and above	\$0
Education support centre	

Enrolment-linked base allocation of \$400,000.

### **Education support school**

Tailored for each school depending on the split of primary and secondary students, with a maximum enrolment-linked base allocation of \$600,000 if all students are primary students and \$750,000 if all students are secondary students.

For example, an education support school with 50 secondary students and 50 primary students would receive an enrolment-linked base allocation of \$675,000.
