## Notes:

1. The course fees apply to a full-time, non-concession student and depend on the nominal hours of the chosen electives.
2. Nominal hours for the courses are indicative and will vary due to the electives offered by providers and selected by students.
3. In 2014, diploma and above courses are charged at \$5.53 per student curriculum hour; general industry training courses are charged at \$3.92 per student curriculum hour; and apprenticeships, traineeships and priority industry qualifications are charged at \$2.49 per student curriculum hour.
4. In 2014, there is an annual fee cap of \$2500 for Certificate IV and below. In 2013, there was a semester fee cap of \$626. State Training Providers may deliver the same course over a different number of semesters and due to the application of the fee cap the course fee will differ.
5. In 2014, the fees provided are estimates only for students enrolling in government funded courses in 2014 on a full time basis and do not apply to fee maintained students.
6. Mode of Delivery is classified using the *National Delivery Mode Identifier* of the WA VET Enrolment Data Standard. Modes are: Classroom Based, Electronic Based, Employment Based, Other Delivery (eg correspondence), and Not Applicable (assessment only services eg recognition of prior learning, recognition of current competencies, and credit transfer).
7. Fees for assessment only services vary depending on the type of service provided.
