Challenges Facing Op Deagon 2012

- 1. Strategies/ideas to increase community involvement. Deagon is achieving results in relation to inter-agency development/engagement and interacting/gaining the trust of the local children. The challenge is to develop strategies to create a sense of ownership at a community level.
- 2. From the outset Op Deagon has worked hard to form strong women's groups in both Leonora and Laverton. We have had success with the Leonora Women's group however the Laverton group has struggled to be formed and lacked local motivation to develop the group.
- 3. Development of a workable and realistic handover model for the Goldfields/Esperance District.
- 4. Training deployment to the Lands.
- 5. Sustaining a greater working relationship between Police/DCP/Health/Education as the four key agencies in relation to child protection issues in the Goldfields/Esperance District.
