HON. AMBER JADE SANDERSON to the Parliamentary Secretary representing the Minister for Health

I refer to the key performance indicator "% of required staff completed mandatory reporting of child sexual abuse training" in the Midland Health Campus Services Agreement, Schedule 6, Table 3, and I ask:

- 1. What is the target level?
- 2. What is the performance threshold?
- 3. Why is the abatement level only considered to be a 'moderate impact failure' and not a 'high impact failure'?

I thank the honourable member for some notice of this question. The following information has been provided to me by the Minister for Health.

- (1) The target for the KPI relating to the proportion of staff that have completed training in relation to mandatory reporting of child sexual abuse training is the 80th percentile of the WA Metropolitan Peer.
- (2) The threshold target is 50th percentile of the WA Metropolitan Peer.
- (3) The KPI deals with training and does not remove the requirement for mandatory reporting.

Mr President

On behalf of the Minister for Health I provide an update to the answer given to Hon Amber-Jade Sanderson's Question without Notice 363 asked on 26 March 2015.

This question requested information that is Commercial on Confidence within the contract. Subsequent to the answer being provided it has been determined that KPI thresholds and financial arrangements and abatements remain confidential however Operator performance KPIs within the contract are to be made available for the public record.

I seek leave to table the updated response and have it incorporated into Hansard.
