

Community Protection (Offender Reporting) Amendment Regulations 2021

SL 2021/57

Made by the Governor in Executive Council.

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Community Protection (Offender Reporting) Amendment Regulations 2021*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) regulations 1 and 2 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette* (***gazettal day***);
- (b) regulations 3 and 5(1) — on the day after gazettal day;
- (c) the rest of the regulations — on the day on which the *Road Traffic Amendment (Impaired Driving and Penalties) Act 2020* section 37 comes into operation.

3. Regulations amended

These regulations amend the *Community Protection (Offender Reporting) Regulations 2004*.

4. Regulation 3 amended

In regulation 3 delete the definition of ***self-testing breath analysing equipment***.

5. Regulation 26D amended

- (1) Delete regulation 26D(1) and insert:

- (1) In this regulation —
authorised breath tester means an authorised person as defined in the *Road Traffic Act 1974* section 65.

- (2) Delete regulation 26D(3) and insert:

- (3) A sample of a reportable offender's breath may only be tested for the purposes of a breath test by breath testing equipment that is operated in accordance with the

instructions set out in the Breath Analysis
Regulations Schedule 2.

- (3) Delete regulation 26D(6), (7) and (8).
- 6. Regulation 26J deleted**
Delete regulation 26J.
- 7. Schedule 1 Form 4 deleted**
Delete Schedule 1 Form 4.
