Answer

(1-2) The State Government's strong financial management prior to the COVID-19 pandemic ensured Western Australia was better placed than any other state to respond to the economic impacts of the pandemic.

Since the start of the COVID-19 pandemic, the State Government has provided almost \$9 billion in recovery initiatives. In the 2021-22 State Budget, a further \$1 billion has been committed to our COVID-19 response.

I now table a breakdown of COVID-19 recovery initiatives by type and agency.
