- 1. Has the Attorney General received any documents about the voice message, other than the CCC report and its erratum?
- 2. If yes to 1, will you table those documents?

#### Answer

1-2. Yes. As page 7 of Report 1 of the Legislative Assembly Procedure and Privileges Committee states: "The paragraph refers to a text message sent to Mr Phil Edman; the footnote refers to a telephone call". The Office of the Attorney General sought clarification from the Corruption and Crime Commission on this inconsistency in its 'Report on electorate allowances and management of electorate offices', and received a response dated 3 December 2020, which I table.
