PROHIBITION ON FISHING (WIRE TRACE) ORDER 2022 Order No.7 of 2022

Made by the Minister under section 43.

1. Citation

This order is the Prohibition on Fishing (Wire Trace) Order 2022.

2. Interpretation

In this order-

wire trace means a length of steel or metal wire or chain that is attached to, or is part of, a fishing line, but does not include hooks, swivels, or sinkers.

3. Prohibition

A person must not fish from the shore in the area described in the Schedule by the use of a wire trace.

Schedule

All Western Australian waters bounded by a line commencing at a point at 32° 01.295′ south latitude and 115° 45.138′ east longitude (on the mainland); then extending due west along the parallel to a point at 32° 01.295′ south latitude and 115° 44.53′ east longitude; then southerly along the geodesic to a point at 32° 02.47′ south latitude and 115° 43.97′ east longitude; then due east along the parallel to a point at 32° 02.47′ south latitude and 115° 44.15′ east longitude (on the mainland); then generally easterly and northerly along the high water mark to the commencement point.
