
## Hon Donna Faragher to the Leader of the House representing the Minister for Mental Health

I refer to Mother Baby Units providing specialist perinatal support and treatment services and I ask:


- (1) What is the total number of inpatient beds currently available within the Mother Baby Units located at the following hospitals:


- (1) (a) Eight.

The Fiona Stanley Hospital Mother and Baby Unit (MBU) accepts patients from the South Metropolitan Health Service and East Metropolitan Health Service catchments, as well as south rural (Great Southern, south West, Goldfields and Southern Wheatbelt). WA Country Health Service residents have access to both the KEMH MBU and the Fiona Stanley Hospital MBU.
- (3) No other public facilities.
