Part 1 — Preliminary

1. Citation

These regulations are the *Attorney General Regulations Amendment (Legal Profession) Regulations 2022*.

2. Commencement

These regulations come into operation as follows —

- (a) Part 1 — on the day on which these regulations are published in the *Gazette*;
- (b) Part 5 — immediately after the *Attorney General Regulations Amendment (Fees and Charges) Regulations 2022* regulation 24 comes into operation;
- (c) Part 6 — immediately after the *Attorney General Regulations Amendment (Fees and Charges) Regulations 2022* regulation 27 comes into operation;
- (d) the rest of the regulations — on the day on which the *Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2022* section 6 comes into operation.
