HOLIDAY HOMES AMENDMENT LOCAL LAW 2022

1 Title

This is the City of Busselton Holiday Homes Amendment Local Law 2022.

2. Commencement

In clause 3.4(2), delete "24 hours" and insert—

12 hours

7. Schedule 2 amended

In Schedule 2—

- (a) delete the modified penalty of "\$400.00" and insert— \$450.00
- (b) delete each modified penalty of "\$300.00" and insert— \$350.00
- (c) delete the modified penalty of "\$200.00" and insert—\$250.00
