In accordance with section 65 of the *Financial Management Act 2006* (FMA), I wish to advise that I will not be able to table in Parliament the 2021-22 Annual Report for both the Department of Jobs, Tourism, Science and Innovation (JTSI) and Tourism Western Australia (Tourism WA) within the prescribed 90-day period after the end of the 2021-22 financial year, as required under section 64(1) of the FMA.

JTSI and Tourism WA's 2021-22 Annual Reports and the opinion of the Auditor General will not be ready for tabling due to the delayed delivery of the final Audit Opinions from the Office of the Auditor General. The alternate tabling provisions of the FMA are unable to be effectively utilised in this circumstance for this year.

It is anticipated the Annual Reports will be tabled in both Houses of Parliament on the next sitting date of 25 October 2022, pending delivery of the final Audit Opinion in line with this timeframe.
