Reconstitution of the Ministry

President, members will be aware of the reconstitution of the Ministry that occurred on Wednesday, 14 December 2022, involving the appointment of two Ministers and the allocation of portfolios between Ministers, and the appointment of five Parliamentary Secretaries.


