LATE TABLING OF THE CORRUPTION AND CRIME COMMISSION, OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC TRUSTEE, AND PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS COUNCIL 2022-23 ANNUAL REPORTS

Further to previous advice provided by the Treasurer, I wish to advise that the 2022-23 Annual Reports of the Corruption and Crime Commission, the Office of the Public Trustee and the Professional Standards Council are unable to be tabled before Parliament by the later date of 10 October 2023, as previously advised.

I have recently been advised that the audited financial statements for the agencies will not be ready to allow tabling by 10 October 2023 as anticipated.

In accordance with section 65 of the Financial Management Act 2006, I give notice that;

- 2022-23 Annual Report of the Professional Standards Council is anticipated to be tabled in both Houses of Parliament by 7 November 2023;
- 2022-23 Annual Report of the Corruption and Crime Commission is anticipated to be tabled in both Houses of Parliament by 30 November 2023; and
- 2022-23 Annual Report of the Office of the Public Trustee is anticipated to be tabled in both Houses of Parliament by the first sitting day of 2024.
