

GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES - CORPORATE BOX AT SUBIACO OVAL

1692. Mr T.R. Buswell to the Minister for Child Protection; Communities; Seniors and Volunteering; Peel

Do any departments, agencies, or taxpayer funded entities within the Minister's portfolio have a corporate box at Subiaco Oval and, if so -

- (1) How much does the box cost to hire for the year?
- (2) What is the purpose of the box and benefit to Western Australian taxpayers?
- (3) Was the box in use on either of the two nights of the Robbie Williams concerts on 30 November and 1 December this year?
- (4) If yes to (3) -
 - (a) who attended the box for each concert;
 - (b) how much was spent to hire the box on each concert night; and
 - (c) what was the total amount spent on food and alcohol on each night?
 - (d) what financial contribution did each guest make to the cost of the hire of the box and consumables?
