

ALBANY HIGHWAY — HEAVY HAULAGE VEHICLES

Petition

DR A.D. BUTI (Armadale) [12.01 pm]: I have a petition that seems to be in accordance with standing orders of the Assembly and has 110 signatures —

To the Honourable the Speaker and Members of the Legislative Assembly of the Parliament of Western Australia in Parliament assembled.

We, the undersigned, request that the Barnett Government promote the use of alternate routes for heavy haulage vehicles using Albany Highway between Armadale and Kelmscott, by installing appropriate signage on Tonkin Highway, Albany Highway and Armadale Road. We also request the Government to undertake a campaign to educate transport companies and drivers about the alternate routes and excessive use of brakes by heavy haulage vehicles along the Albany Highway.
