1462. Mr Z.R.F. Kirkup to the Minister for Child Protection:

I refer to your answer to Question on Notice No. 68 regarding expenditure by the Department of Child Protection and Family Support and ask:

- (a) Over what period of time did the Department spend \$22,813.41 on professional print services;
- (b) Who provided these services;
- (c) What documents were printed by these service providers; and
- (d) Will the Minister table a copy of each professionally printed document:
 - (i) If not, why not?

Ms S.F. McGurk replied:

- (a) The Department spent \$22 813.41 on professional print services between 17 March 2017 and 17 May 2017.
- (b) The printing services were provided by a range of suppliers.
- (c) A range of documents were printed, including but not limited to, publications; safety notices; business cards and certificates.
- (d) Yes, tabled for the member's information are some examples of the printed publications:

 - Building Safe and Strong Families
