

DIVISION 37: DISABILITY SERVICES COMMISSION —

Question: Mr D.A. Templeman asked for the current figures of the number of disability services accommodation clients under the old regime of 50 per cent compared to those on the new regime of 75 per cent.

Answer: As at 1 June 2010 there were 530 clients in Disability Services Commission accommodation facilities. On this date, 525 clients were being charged 75 per cent of their pension income for board and lodgings and five clients were being charged 50 per cent. As at 7 June 2010, 100 per cent of Commission clients were being charged 75 per cent of their pension income for board and lodgings.
