

HIGH STREET–STIRLING HIGHWAY — UPGRADE

**510. Ms S.F. McGurk to the Minister for Transport:**

I refer to the High Street–Stirling Highway upgrade project and the subsequent noise testing in the area undertaken as part of this project and I ask:

- (a) what is the data from the most recent noise testing completed for the Duke Street area;
- (b) can the Minister please detail any previous data collected from noise testing in the Duke Street area;
- (c) will the Department of Transport undertake air quality monitoring to measure the level of emissions from diesel trucks; and
- (d) does the Minister plan to construct noise walls along Stirling Highway, in the section from Canning Highway to High Street, as part of the upgrade project?

**Mr T.R. Buswell replied:**

Main Roads WA advises:

- (a) Main Roads is awaiting the results from its acoustic consultant.
- (b) Main Roads has not conducted nor is it aware of any previous monitoring or modelling at the Duke Street area.
- (c) Main Roads has engaged a consultant to conduct an air quality assessment and Main Roads is awaiting the results.
- (d) The section of Stirling Highway between Marmion Street and Canning Highway is not included in the project scope.
